Our newly formed friendship strengthens both organisation's goal to empower young people and invest in a youth-driven future. Our Cooperation Agreement aims to develop key competencies and provide much-needed support and guidance to young people who pass through our organisations.

It has never been more evident as in the past year that there's indeed a global skills crisis and many young people are struggling to launch their careers or find meaning in what they do. Young people around the globe are required to rethink and re-evaluate the competencies and skills they have, and the job markets they hope to get into.
